DETAILS:	<p>Aim:</p> <p>Young people's exchanging ideas-information about democracy</p> <p>Objectives:</p> <p>To practice minimal democracy practice by creating a democratic debate environment in the classroom.</p> <p>Achievements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teaching the practice of democracy by experiencing it. • Realizing the impact of expressing opinions on personal development. <p>Related Vocabulary:</p> <p>Human rights, justice, social development, debate culture</p>
HOW TO USE THIS LESSON:	<p>Activities:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The related video in VAEIE Project Democracy module is watched. 2. Students presents their thoughts on the video they watched within a specified time . The teacher asks students the question: "What kind of idea did the film give you?". 3. The teacher asks students to associate the film and the following concepts. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Republic ○ Equality ○ Human Rights ○ Justice ○ Social Development 4. Students are asked to comment on each other's thoughts. 5. The relevant module is opened in the VAEIE Project and the teacher gives information about the subject.
