The teacher shows the students photos from the social life of the African and European continents.</li> <li>2. The teacher asks the students to make inferences about equality with these photographs.</li> <li>3. About the photos the teacher asks the students: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o to compare photos of two continents</li> <li>o to relate the concept of equality through these photographs taken from two different continents (Africa and Europe)</li> </ul> </li> <li>4. The related video in the VAEIE Project Equality module is watched.</li> <li>5. Young people express their thoughts about the video.</li> </ol>
